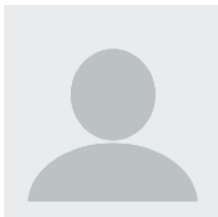
Jessica Bohman

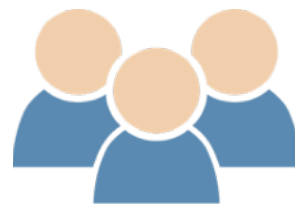
Jerry Scott

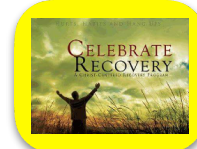
Message from our Executive Director
