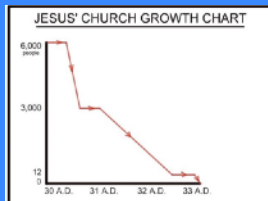


We offer our workshops :

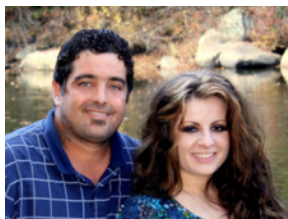
Doug founded **Magdalene Hope**, that helps prostitutes being trafficked and offers them a way out to escape their pimp, detox and safely restart their life elsewhere.

Doug Spears



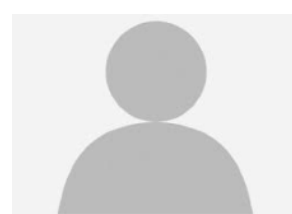
Doug is the Northern WV rep with **Celebrate Recovery** that helps those with hang-ups, hurts or habits to overcome and recover from those addictions and behavior.

Kit & Joann Kindred



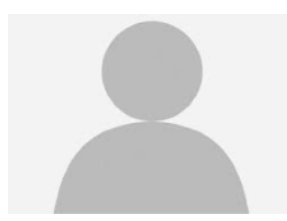
Kit & Joann have been caring for and training people all of their adult life. Now retired they have not stopped and continue to think out of the box ways to help people.
